Seeking Education and Work Experience?

► **Project FUTRE is a paid Certification & Apprenticeship Program** designed to offer both education and work experience. Become a Behavioral Health Paraprofessional trained to work with families that experience the impacts of opioid or substance use. Apprentices will reach out and support other parents and family members through their own lived experiences.

Certification Training: \$5,500 stipend + up to \$500 completion bonus!

- Six-month scholarship for certification training in Family Support and Recovery concepts.
- Time commitment – 6 hours class time weekly plus homework assignments.
- Certification as Parent and Family Support Specialist (must qualify).
- CPR/First Aid and assistance with AZ Fingerprint Clearance.
- Hands on learning and job shadowing with a local health and wellness organization.

Apprenticeship (optional): \$7,000 stipend + up to \$500 completion bonus!

- Twelve-month employment opportunity with local health and wellness organization, if available, as an apprentice (additional application).
- Full-time hours and health benefits.
- Mentorship and clinical guidance.
